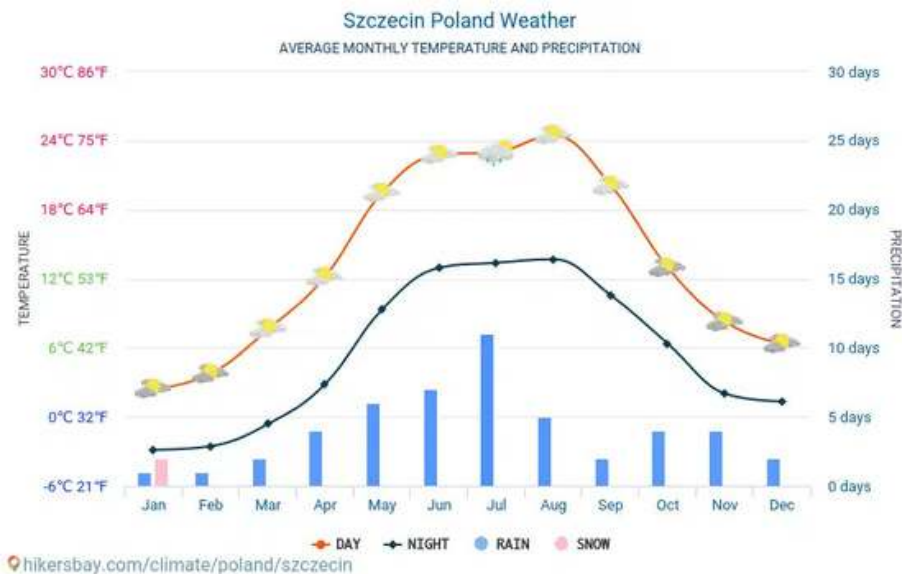
GENERAL INFORMATION

BRIEF INTRODUCTION

Szczecin is one of the largest cities in north-western Poland, located on the Oder River, close to the German border and not far from the Baltic Sea. The city combines a rich history with the modern character of an important port center. It is known for its vast green areas, wide avenues inspired by the Parisian urban layout, the Chrobry Embankment with panoramic river views, and the Pomeranian Dukes' Castle. Szczecin offers a unique blend of architecture, culture, water, and nature, creating a calm yet dynamic atmosphere.

WEATHER

In May, the average temperature in Szczecin typically ranges between 12–20°C. Spring brings increasing sunshine, although occasional rain showers may occur. Layered clothing and a light jacket are recommended. During the day, temperatures can be pleasantly warm, while evenings may feel cooler, especially near the river or in open areas.



CURRENCY & PAYMENT OPTIONS

The official currency in Szczecin is the Polish Złoty (PLN). Credit and debit cards are widely accepted in hotels, restaurants, shops, and cafés. ATMs are easily available throughout the city, and contactless payments are commonly used.

GENERAL INFORMATION

LOCAL TIPS / USEFUL INFORMATION

Language: The official language in Szczecin is Polish, but English is widely spoken, especially in hotels, restaurants, and tourist areas.

Time: Poland follows Central European Time (CET) and Central European Summer Time (CEST) in summer.

Voltage/Electricity: Poland uses the European two-pin plugs (Type C and Type E). The standard voltage is 230V. Visitors from the UK or outside Europe may need an adapter.

Water: Tap water is safe to drink, though bottled water is widely available in shops.

Banks: Typically open from 9:00 to 17:00 on weekdays. Most are closed on weekends, but ATMs are widely accessible throughout the city.

Emergency Numbers: Dial 112 for any emergency (police, ambulance, fire brigade).

Pharmacies: Well-stocked and available throughout the city. Many pharmacies operate standard business hours, and some offer extended or 24-hour service.

TRANSPORTATION

AIRPORTS & TRANSFERS

AIRPORTS

Solidarity Szczecin–Goleniów Airport:

Located approximately 45 km from the city center of Szczecin. The airport offers domestic and selected international connections. The journey to the city center takes about 40–50 minutes by car or train. The most convenient travel option is often to fly first to Warsaw and then take a connecting domestic flight to Goleniów.

Berlin Brandenburg Airport (BER):

Located approximately 140 km from Szczecin. As a major international hub, it offers a wide range of intercontinental and European flights. Travel time to Szczecin is approximately 2–2.5 hours by car or bus.

TRANSFERS

Participants traveling from different countries have several convenient transfer options:

From Solidarity Szczecin–Goleniów Airport:

- Train: Direct regional trains operate between the airport station and Szczecin Główny (main railway station). The journey takes around 45 minutes.
- Taxi: Available outside the terminal; travel time to the city center or to Courtyard by Marriott Szczecin City is approximately 40–50 minutes.
- Private transfer: Can be arranged in advance through various transport providers.

From Berlin Brandenburg Airport (BER):

- Direct bus: International bus services (e.g., FlixBus) operate regularly between Berlin Airport and Szczecin city center. The journey takes approximately 2–2.5 hours.
- Train: Train connections via Berlin Hauptbahnhof (main station) to Szczecin Główny are also available.
- Private transfer: Pre-booked transfers or car rental are convenient options for direct travel to the hotel.

TRANSPORTATION

TRANSFER TO THE HOTEL

The meeting venue, Courtyard by Marriott Szczecin City, is located in the city center, within the Posejdon complex.

- From Szczecin Główny railway station, the hotel is about 3 minutes by taxi or approximately 12 minutes on foot (1 km).
- Local trams and buses also connect the main station with the city center.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION (WITHIN SZCZECIN)

Szczecin has a well-developed network of trams and buses, providing convenient and affordable transportation across the city. Tickets can be purchased from ticket machines or via mobile apps.

Taxis and ride-hailing services are widely available.
The city center is compact and walkable, making it easy to explore on foot.

SIGHTSEEING

Some popular places to explore while in Szczecin include:

- **Zamek Książąt Pomorskich** – A Renaissance castle and one of the city’s most important landmarks, once the seat of the Dukes of Pomerania. Today it hosts exhibitions, concerts, and cultural events.
- **Wały Chrobrego** – A panoramic riverside promenade offering spectacular views of the Oder River, the port, and impressive historic buildings.
- **Stare Miasto w Szczecinie** – The Old Town area with reconstructed historic buildings, charming streets, cafés, and restaurants near the Market Square.
- **Filharmonia im. Mieczysława Karłowicza w Szczecinie** – An award-winning concert hall known for its striking modern architecture and outstanding acoustics.
- **Jasne Błonia** – A vast green square lined with trees, perfect for relaxing walks and outdoor activities.
- **Park Kasprowicza** – One of the largest parks in the city, featuring walking paths, a lake (Rusałka), and the Summer Theatre.
- **Muzeum Narodowe w Szczecinie** – A museum complex presenting art, maritime heritage, and regional history.
- **Jezioro Szmaragdowe** – A picturesque emerald-colored lake located in the Beech Forest, ideal for nature lovers.
- **Puszcza Bukowa** – A large forest area south of the city, perfect for hiking and cycling.
